





The Association was formed in 1992 as the New Mexico Emergency Preparedness Association, and later changed to the New Mexico Emergency Management Association. The Association is governed by its members and an Executive Board, with a Constitution and Bylaws.

Membership is open to any individual interested in emergency management in New Mexico, whether currently employed in that capacity or not.

New memberships can be accepted at any time (with dues prorated); renewals are payable by the calendar year. If dues are paid with personal funds, the membership stays with the member, while dues paid with agency funds are presumed to stay with the position when the member leaves.

General Meetings and Executive Board Meetings are both held quarterly, and are open to any interested person.

Officers of the Association serve two-year terms with a limit of two consecutive terms. The President and Secretary are elected in even-numbered years, the Vice President and Treasurer in odd years.
