Governor's Commission on Disability along with the NM Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management Region 3 Designated Representatives who are Emergency Managers will host a presentation to the Access and Functional Needs Communities of the Santa Fe, Los Alamos, Rio Arriba and Taos Counties.
